Promoting Fundamental British Values

Policy statement

We recognise the requirement from the Department for Education to ensure children are protected from radicalisation by those wishing unduly or illegally influence them with extreme views.

Procedures

We are committed to teaching 'British Values' which the Government defines as:

- democracy
- the rule of Law
- Individual liberty and personal responsibility
- mutual respect
- tolerance of those of different culture faiths and beliefs

Examples

Children are treated with respect and their views are listened to. We provide choices for them wherever possible.

We teach children how to behave appropriately and discuss behavioural issues.

We help children understand the need to keep them safe and why we have certain rules. We encourage children to help each other and to respect their environment. We promote and encourage independence from the young age.

We use stories etc. to teach empathy and understanding. We support children with sharing and taking turns. The adults and other children provide good role models for each other. We speak respectfully to each other. As part of a balance range of experiences on offer we will learn about British festivals/events such as St. George's day or large sporting events.

We will learn about their place in the wider world through books resources and discussions.
