Communication is key to helping children understand something new. Story books and photos can support children's understanding of something new and unfamiliar. Exploring books about starting school can provide a starting point for conversations.

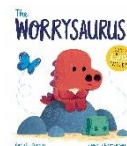
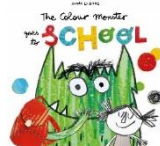
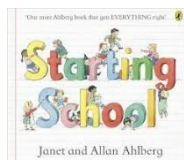
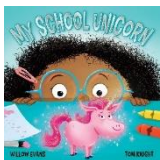
